Wine description

Very intense, aromatic nose, showing notes of exotic fruits like mango, lychee or citrus, as well as floral flavours with a light smokey finish. Due to its early ripeness and high sugar levels the variety is predestined for producing dessert wines. For production of dry wines grapes should be harvested at max. 22°Brix to prevent aroma loss.

Berries remain green, even at high must weight levels High number of watershoots, recommendation: plant highstem vines Good fertility of basal buds
